21/117 To receive information from Hyde Architecture – Daniel Hyde.

The Chair welcomed Daniel Hyde and Ian Robinson to the meeting. Daniel informed the Parish Council that they are now looking at erecting one dwelling in the first paddock and the intention is for a traditional Lincolnshire style of house. He said that they have liaised with neighbours and wanted to inform the Parish Council of the type of house they are proposing. The classroom facility would continue and the house was essential to support the agricultural and equine business. The Chair thanked them both for attending the meeting.

21/120 Questions raised by members of the public on agenda items (15 minutes).

The Chair welcomed Mr and Mrs Guest and thanked them for offering their garden for the Queens Platinum Jubilee event proposed for Sunday 5th June 2022. The Parish Council explained what was required. Insurance concerns were raised, and it was agreed that the Clerk would check the Parish Council's Insurance policy to make sure this type of event was covered.

21/122 Police Report

The Police were unable to attend the meeting, but a Police Report was submitted. The clerk distributed copies of the report to Councillors prior to the meeting. There have been twenty-one crimes reported in the Waltham Ward. Cllr Pettigrew mentioned the non-attendance of the Police and it was agreed that the clerk raised this matter with them. **RESOLVED: Clerk to place Police Report on the Notice Board, website and to find out when the new PCSO would be able to attend meetings.**

21/123 Highways / Public Footpaths / Items Carried Forward:

- 09/104 Whitsend Farm – Clerk advised that no update has been received in time for the meeting. Noted.
- 20/072 FP89 Safety Issues – Clerk advised that the footpath officer has confirmed that this matter is on his list of jobs. Clerk to contact the footpath officer to ascertain a start date.
- 21/0554-5 Village Green – Clerk advised that work on the trees is scheduled for 10th February 2022. Cllr Pettigrew advised that he has not seen the application for the TPO's. **Resolved: Clerk to check if the application has been approved.**
- Clerk Vacancy – Clerk advised that two applications forms were received for the position, but one has been withdrawn. The Parish Council discussed the application received and agreed to invite her to the next meeting. **Resolved: Clerk to contact applicant to invite her to March meeting.**
- Queens Platinum Jubilee – Sunday 5th June 2022. The Parish Council discussed the format of the event and agreed that prices for BBQ be obtained. **Resolved: Clerk to obtain prices.**

21/124 Items for Discussion

1. Grass Cutting Tenders – Clerk advised that she had contacted three contractors and only received one tender. **Resolved: The Parish Council agreed that another tender was required for comparison.**
2. Dog Fouling – Clerk advised that a Brigsley resident has raised concerns regarding the amount of dog fouling within Ashby cum Fenby. The Parish Council already have dog fouling notices on most of the public rights of ways and have previously placed this matter within newsletters asking dog owners to help keep the area free of dog fouling. **Resolved: The Parish Council agreed to place this matter in their next newsletter.**
3. Newsletter – The Parish Council discussed and agreed that the next newsletter should be published end of April to promote the Queens Platinum Jubilee. **Resolved: Clerk to prepare a poster and place on the notice board, website and Facebook.**

Waltham, Brigsley & Ashby-cum-Fenby February Update

Crime

There were 21 crimes reported during January for the Waltham Ward. Of these, the following offences have occurred.

Overnight 5th & 6th January a home on Manor Drive was entered via the insecure front door. Keys to a Ford Transit van were taken which were then used to drive the vehicle away.

On 10th January a Ford Transit van was stolen after a male attended the owners address to take the van for a test drive. The van was never returned.

Late in the evening of 24th January a Ford Transit van parked on Woodhall Drive was set alight.

A male has been charged with threats to cause damage and firearms offences following a domestic incident on 8th January.

Other crime includes:

Four assaults.

Five shop theft from the Co-Op.

Three minor public order offences.

There have been no reports of ASB.
