E-Bikes project in North East Lincolnshire

North East Lincolnshire Council and its partner, ENGIE, are currently seeking funding to provide residents with the opportunity to try out electrically assisted bikes (e-bikes or e-trikes).

There is a growing trend to get more people cycling to improve health, support the recovery from COVID-19 and tackle the environmental impacts of everyday journeys. Initially, the aim is to find out if a scheme whereby residents could get subsidised access to an e-bike / e-trike for a limited 'trial' period.
