20/016 Police Report

The Police were unable to attend the meeting, but a Police Report was submitted. The clerk distributed copies of the Police Report to Councillors prior to the meeting. There have been six crimes reported in the Waltham Ward. Chair mentioned that Cllr Pettigrew reported that a black Audi was seen down his lane.

20/017 Highways / Public Footpaths / Items Carried Forward

- 09/104 Whitsend Farm – The Parish Council discussed the recent email received from NELC and that no further action was required. **Action: On going.**
- 19/060-1 The Stables – Clerk advised that this matter has still not been given a decision date by the Planning Inspectorate. **Action: On going.**
- 20/007-1 Standing Orders – The Clerk distributed copies of the virtual meetings procedures to Councillors prior to the meeting. **Resolved: The Parish Council agreed to adopt the virtual meeting process.**
- 20/007-2 Newsletter Topics – The Parish Council discussed the benefits a register of resident's email addresses, which would assist in passing on up to date information. Another topic for inclusion was to make residents aware of the Facebook page and see if anyone

would like to contribute items of interest for future Newsletters. **Action: Councillors to communicate with the clerk if they have any additional items.**

Crime

There have been nine crimes reported in the Waltham Ward during April.

On the afternoon of 10th April two unknown males in a car approached a female walking her dog on Station Road. They tried to speak to her, so she ran off. The car approached her again and a member of the public intervened. The car drove away.

Cash was stolen after a male was allowed to enter and wait for his partner who was working in the home.

The seven other offences are all of a domestic nature including five assaults.

There has been one report of ASB. Report of a drone being flown over gardens in the area of Fairway.
